Case in Point Authors' Guide

Authors are asked to follow the guidelines listed below for Case in Point submissions to *The Canadian Journal of Diagnosis*.

Article Length

- The text of the article should be no longer than 250 words
- The text should be divided into three sections:
 - A case presentation
 - 2 or 3 questions pertaining to the article with multiple choice answers (*e.g.*, What's the diagnosis? What's the treatment?)
 - A short summary of the condition, including how to diagnose and treat

Article Components:

In addition to the text, the article should contain:

- Presentation of a case and case discussion
- 1 photograph illustrating the case. **Digital images should be at least 450 DPI at their original size and saved in JPEG format**
- References for studies and statistics only

Author Information:

- Complete contact information (mailing address, telephone and fax numbers, and e-mail address)
- Affiliations (academic and hospital-based) for lead author and other authors
- Author and co-author names in the order they should appear and corresponding credentials
