Photo Diagnosis Authors' Guide

Authors are asked to follow the guidelines listed below for Photo Diagnosis submissions to *The Canadian Journal of Diagnosis*.

Article Length

- The text of the article should be no longer than 200 words
- The text should be divided into three sections:
 - Case Presentation (40–50 words)
 - Questions about the Case (2–3 questions)
 - Answers (100–150 words total)

Article Components:

In addition to the text, the article should contain:

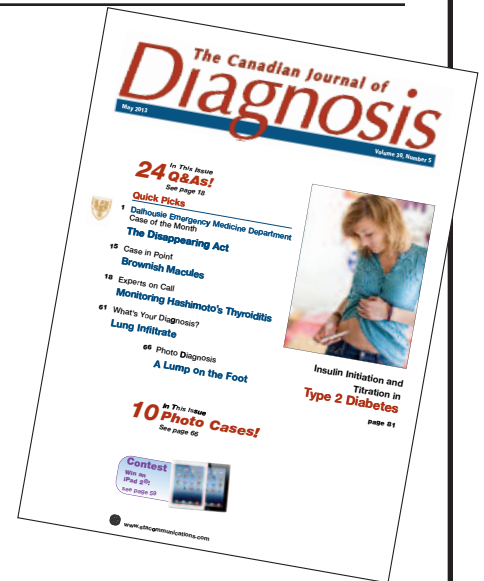
- Presentation of a case and case discussion
- Questions about the case (for example, “what is the diagnosis?” and “what is the treatment?”)
- Between one and two photographs illustrating the case. Digital images should be at least 450 DPI at their original size and saved in JPEG format

Author Information:

- Complete contact information (mailing address, telephone and fax numbers, and e-mail address)
- Credentials and affiliations (academic and hospital-based) for lead author and other authors
- Author and co-author names in the order they should appear
