## What's Your Diagnosis? Authors' Guide

Authors are asked to follow the guidelines listed below for What's Your Diagnosis? submissions to *The Canadian Journal of Diagnosis*.

### Article Length

- The text of the article should be no longer than 500 words
- The text should be divided into three sections:
  - A case presentation
  - A list of multiple choice answers to the question "What's the Diagnosis?"
  - A short summary of the condition, including how to diagnose and treat

### Article Components:

**In addition to the text, the article should contain:**

- Presentation of a case and case discussion
- Up to 3 photographs illustrating the case. Digital images should be at least 450 DPI at their original size and saved in JPEG format
- References for studies and statistics only

### Author Information:

- Complete contact information (mailing address, telephone and fax numbers, and e-mail address )
- Affiliations (academic and hospital-based) for lead author and other authors
- Author and co-author names in the order they should appear and corresponding credentials
