In 2004, Kansas City University of Medicine and Biosciences (KCU) expanded its mission to include greater emphasis on research and discovery, and established the College of Biosciences (COB). In 2006, the COB conferred its first master of science in biomedical sciences degree. Whether your interest is in working toward discoveries in a biomedical research laboratory, or continuing a pathway in higher education to earn a doctoral degree, COB teaches you the skills you need to become an immediate contributor in the growing life sciences industry.

OUR PROGRAM MASTER OF SCIENCE IN BIOMEDICAL SCIENCES

The master of science in biomedical sciences program at KCU provides students with the skills necessary for a successful and rewarding career as a research scientist in a biomedical laboratory or a solid foundation to pursue doctoral programs in medicine or the life sciences. KCU offers two options for students interested in pursuing the accredited master of science in biomedical sciences degree. Students may apply for the 12-month track or the 24-month research track program.

The 12-month, classroom intensive track includes coursework in anatomy, biochemistry, cell biology, epidemiology, genetics, immunology, molecular biology, physiology, and research design and methodology. Emphasis is placed on state-of-the-art research methodologies and protocols, regardless of the chosen field.

The 24-month research track is designed for individuals interested in careers as research scientists in major laboratories and includes additional emphasis on advanced courses allowing students the opportunity to work side by side with faculty researchers on projects that are unique and on the cutting edge of the field.
