Colin Maier is an oboist and multi-instrumentalist who is also a dancer, actor, stuntman, singer, martial artist, and Cirque de Soleil acrobat. Originally from Calgary, he has performed with orchestras across Canada and in shows such as *Lord of the Rings*, *Amadeus*, *Cats*, *A Chorus Line*, and *Sarah Brightman's World Tour*. During the 2010 Winter Olympic opening ceremony in Vancouver, he was featured as the Devil Fiddler in the Flying Blue Canoe. Since 2009, he has performed around the world as a member of Quartetto Gelato.

### **Mark Camilleri – piano**

Pianist, composer, arranger, and producer Mark Camilleri is the Music Director for The Tenors and director/producer of hundreds of theatre and musical productions in Canada. He has worked with some of show business' biggest names, such as Il Divo, Celine Dion, Sting, Eric Clapton, Herbie Hancock, Jim Cuddy, and many more, and has produced award-winning CD's for Jeff Healey, The Toronto Symphony Orchestra, Alan Thicke, and others.

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
