



Adult Dual Credit - Trades Introduction

Dual Credits: one high school credit and one college course.

*To be eligible for this program students must be 21 years of age or older, aiming to complete an Ontario Secondary School Diploma.

Course: Welding Basics

TLH4T (College Course: WLD001)

Students will learn all aspects of welding and shop safety, including general, personal, welding and industrial shop safety. Students will study and operate Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW,) Gas Metal Arc Welding (GMAW) and Oxy Fuel Cutting (OFC) processes. This course also includes the study of power sources, electrodes and consumables, basic welds and welding procedures.

Note:

- Tuition, materials, equipment, and transportation will be covered through the Dual Credit program.
- Students will be contacted by the SCWI Program Assistant, at least one week prior to the start of the program, to be provided with a date, time and location for an orientation session.
- Delivery: April to June, 2026. Commerce Court Campus.
