Dual Credits: two high school credits and two college courses

Anatomy and Physiology – PHW4T (College Course: IAP100)

This course introduces the learner to the normal development, structures and functions of the human body. The learner will examine the physiological components of the human body in order to obtain understanding on how the structures and functions of the body are related.

Introduction to Substance Abuse – HDX4T (College Course: MHA180) This course provides an introduction to the history of substance use, including its social and economic context. The course outlines various theories of substance use from their origins to present day, highlighting the cultural and societal influences that impact use patterns. This course examines the most prevalent drugs, the common myths surrounding addiction, and the state of current drug policy in Canada. An overview of substance abuse screening and assessment, treatment settings and approaches, and concurrent disorders is considered.

- Tuition, materials and transportation fees will be covered through the Dual Credit program.
- All students are expected to attend an orientation session prior to taking part in any Dual Credit program.
