Dual Credits: two high school credits and Level 1 Apprenticeship General Carpenter

General Carpenter – TSA4Y (College Course: 403A) Level 1 In-school Curriculum

Apprentices can expect to cover a wide scope of the carpenter trade, which includes many aspects of building construction. Carpenters work primarily in one area of specialization within the trade, such as concrete forming, framing, finishing, interior systems and scaffolding.

This is a theory-based course; students taking this program should either have already taken co-operative education in a related field or be currently involved with an employer.

- Tuition, materials, equipment and transportation fees will be covered through the Dual Credit program.
- Delivery: Block release (8-weeks full-time) to complete the program - required 240 hours. August - October, 2022.
- Location: Commerce Court Campus.
- Students involved in this program will be excused from their regular classes or co-op to attend the College.
