6.1 CSC Activity Report (Student Representative)

6.3 Sustainability/Technology/Strategic Direction

- CSC supporting student inquiry about the creation of vegetable gardens and other local planting
- Discussion about potential technology we could bring in to add more value to student learning (i.e. - data gathering device, data gathering hub, etc.)
- Discussion around staff garbage and recycling. To the committee's knowledge, the blue bins in offices are not being recycled, how do we encourage individuals to recycle at the larger recycling areas?

6.4 How to Better Support International Students

- Concerns have been brought forward about changes to academic break periods which have negatively affected students. Jacob to inquire about this and will bring it forward to see if a recommendation can be made by Council (if appropriate) - JACOB ACTION ITEM
- Discussion around international student health insurance and their ability to access insurance information before the 10-day count is complete, which is when they are currently receiving their policy information. CSC recommended an information session for international health insurance during orientation. Discussion around when the list is being submitted to GuardMe Jacob to investigate and bring information back—JACOB ACTION ITEM
