4.0 Update on Previous Action Items

Edits to the website

Accessible/Safe Space Washrooms

- Confirmed with George that concerns are being addressed and things are on their way
- Confirmed that signage has been created and is pending approval

<u>Provision of sanitary products in Canadore bathrooms</u>

- Council will make a formal recommendation to the Board of Governors to provide sanitary products to further support the effort
- Confirmed that this is currently in the process of being reviewed between various student service departments. In the interim, any students that require sanitary products can reach out to student services for assistance

Option to opt-out of bus pass fees

After investigating it was determined that it is not possible to opt out of the bus pass
 due to bulk purchasing for reduced pricing

5.0 College Council Workload Recommendations

- Council members revisited the discussion surrounding incentives for College Council members to encourage involvement and participation and decided on the following:
 - Continued concern around optics and the nature of the position as voluntary and fairness and equity of the monetary compensation as it relates to different worker categories and collective agreements were discussed
 - Suggestion to see what other Colleges are doing for recognition ACTION ITEM
 MELISSA
 - Decision to forgo the discussion around monetary compensation in future meetings
- The above recommendations were put to a vote (Unanimous)

6.0 How to Better Support International Students

- Revisited this topic with additional council members who were able to provide insight to the rest of the council members regarding current international needs and support available. Additionally, the council members were provided with an overview of the future strategic plans for international enrollment and recruitment. Recognizing that there will be a larger physical presence of international students in Fall 2023. Council discussion and recommendations included:
 - General education courses
 - Language supports a drop-in center opposed to the current booking system which may be a barrier – Caroline advised more to come surrounding a new model for the ESL lab for the College Drive Campus
 - Having students arrive earlier in the semester to offer language services to assist with the climatization of a new environment before the start of the semester
 - Having an immigration lawyer service available

- From our previous meeting we have since confirmed that international students can be peer tutors
- The committee put forward to add this to the "standing items" list to be discussed at each
 meeting if the council members think of new ideas for increasing the support to
 international students
- The above recommendation was put to a vote (Unanimous)
