This multidisciplinary program offers theoretical and practical training on fixed and rotary wing aircraft. Learn to troubleshoot vital aircraft components and systems including the engine, hydraulics and landing gear. Intensive structures training in the third year includes: damage inspection and evaluation, manufacturing and repair techniques, and advanced fitting and assembly procedures.

Note: Graduates receive 24 months of accreditation towards a Transport Canada-issued Aircraft Maintenance Engineer's Licence Category M or 12 months towards Category S. Class attendance is mandatory.

Note I: These programs have been designed to enable students to enhance their education and build upon their aircraft maintenance skills with an additional specification in Avionics or Structures. The first two years of the program are common with the Aviation Technician - Aircraft Maintenance program. Transfer opportunities exist for graduates of a Transport Canada accredited school who have met the applicable requirements of STD566.10.

Note II: Successful completion of these programs will result in 24 months accreditation toward an Aircraft Maintenance Engineer (AME) Category M Licence. These are the first programs of their kind in Ontario and the first in Canada to be eligible for the full 24-month accreditation granted by Transport Canada. Class attendance is mandatory.
