

Academic Award Criteria

Academic Honours

Recognition of student academic achievement

GPA of 3.7 or higher
 Will automatically appear on the student transcript

Program Achievement Awards

Recognition of Academic Excellence in Program of Study

- Must have 3.7 GPA or higher
- Must be graduating from an Ontario College Certificate, Diploma, or Advanced Diploma
 Recipient selected by coordinator and faculty

Board of Governors Awards (Program Area Achievement Awards)

Recognition of a student's academic excellence within the program area Recipient chosen from the pool of Program Achievement Award winners (above)

- Must have a 3.7 GPA or higher
- Must be graduating from an Ontario College Certificate, Diploma, or Advanced Diploma Recipient selected by coordinator and faculty

Governor General's Award

Recipient chosen from pool of Board of Governors Awards winners (above)

Must have 4.0 GPA and be graduating from an Ontario College Diploma, or Advanced Diploma

Other criteria for consideration:

- Amount of work done by candidate in program and relative difficulty of outcomes on a program-by-program basis
- Documentation to support the candidate including letters of recommendation from faculty
- Leadership abilities, and involvement and commitment to one's educational institution and community

Recognizes one graduating student each academic year for excellence in student leadership and contribution to the community and College. Details are sent out by email to all students

- * Students must apply for this award*
 - Must have 3.7 GPA or higher
 - A letter of reference from a faculty member is also required
 - Also considers the applicant's extracurricular activities within the College and community
