One such event will be International Student Orientation set to be held in-person at the end of August/beginning of September!





COMING IN FALL 2022: ONLINE ACCESS TO TRANSCRIPTS AND CREDENTIALS!

Canadore students and graduates will soon have online access to their official transcript and other credentials thanks to a new digital platform.

Launching at Canadore this Fall, transcripts will be issued through MyCreds, powered by Digitary. These digital credentials can be shared securely with post-secondary institutions, employers or other third parties. The documents, which can only be issued at the student's request, are tamper-evident and cryptographically signed, making them authentic and official.


Canadore students and graduates will also be able to download PDF copies of their transcripts and documents from MyCreds platform and print out unofficial paper copies of their transcripts from the PDFs.

Culture shock and social isolation: You're not alone

Every year, more than 500 000 international students come to

Canada, many of which experience feelings of loneliness, social isolation and culture shock in the first few months.

According to research, international students will experience a sort of rollercoaster of emotions beginning with excitement followed by culture shock and loneliness and finally adjusting and adapting to your new surroundings.

Culture shock is not a sign that anything is wrong. It is normal and eventually goes away leaving you with fond memories when you look back to this time.

Living and attending school abroad is a fantastic opportunity to experience different cultures and traditions – both the positives and negatives are what makes this an adventure!

Many resources are available in the College as well as online to help with your initial feelings of culture shock and isolation. INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SPOTLIGHT

For Sameer, the journey to Canada was a fearful and sad one – not the typical international student experience of excitement and awe. It took him and his family a difficult two days to travel from Syria to Jordan where they stayed for a long time before arriving in Canada.

"To come to Canada, required hard work and excellence, such as learning another language, learning the skills you need in your life as a student, and being a strong competitor in a scholarship program in which thousands enrolled; I always sought to develop myself and learn things to help me with my life in Canada.

After finishing high school, I enrolled in many training diplomas, such as managing offices and data analysis, and life skills courses, which helped me get jobs with international organizations in Jordan such as Oxfam and the International Relief Organization. From this point, I started working and enrolled in many volunteer work programs within community support organizations."

It took much perseverance and hard work to overcome difficult barriers before Sameer was finally accepted as a recipient of the WUSC Student Refugee Program.

Sameer arrived at Canadore in Fall 2021 with a warm welcome from the College. He says he chose North Bay as it reminded him of his own hometown. He loves the beauty of North Bay and fondly recalls visiting the Museum to learn of our history. He is especially happy with his experience working in the International Department as an International Student Ambassador.

Sameer graduated this April from the Pre-Health Sciences program and plans on pursuing one of our Mechanical Engineering programs to complete his Engineering degree that he began back home. His ultimate goal is to bring his family here to Canada with him once he graduates.

He says he wants to thank George Burton for receiving him on his first day at the college, Dr. Ahmed Obaide and Dr. Aamir Taiyeb, as well as, the entire staff of the International Department for assisting throughout his academic life at Canadore.

Sameer is very pleased with his experience at Canadore; "My academic experience at the College was an unforgettable part of my life in Canada and I think it is one of the most welcoming colleges for [international] students".
