The Canadore International team hosted a pre-departure orientation session for international students via Zoom on Friday, July 7th, 2023, from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m. EST, over 400 students had participated.

The Pre-Departure Orientation session covered a wide range of topics such as — What to expect while travelling to Canada, What to pack, Transportation, Sim Card, Banking, Housing, Registration and so on.



All international students travelling to Canada were encouraged to participate as several key topics that would help be better prepared for travel/study in Canada were covered.

Canadore Outbound Mobility Program

Canadore will prioritise international mobility for as many of its domestic students and personnel as possible. This includes both short-term and long-term international academic and non-academic exchanges, with a particular emphasis on underrepresented student groups (such as Indigenous students, students with disabilities, and low-income students).

Canadore College has numerous affiliations various institutions across the globe. As a regulated public institution in Canada with a keen interest in foreign collaborations, Canadore continues to seek advantageous international agreements.

A group of 12 Canadore College students and faculty members visited our long-standing partner in the Mexican state of Querétaro, Universidad Aeronáutica en Querétaro (UNAQ), at the end of April 2023. The students had a fantastic cross-border and cross-cultural learning experience that included both academic and non-academic components.

Ways to access healthcare in Canada

Students suffering from minor illnesses such as sore throats, runny noses, colds, coughs, flu, mild fevers, minor rashes, skin irritations, and so on can visit the North Bay Campus Health Centre or Community walk-in clinics. Students are asked to go to the hospital's emergency room if they have a serious illness or injury, such as broken bones, a bad cut, or excessive bleeding.
