

Canadore College welcomes our International Students to Canada-what you need to know

Before leaving your home country you must have downloaded the following two Apps:

- Arrival Can <https://arrivecan.cbsa-asfc.cloud-nuage.canada.ca/privacy>
- iCent App: <https://www.icentapp.com/direct-download.html>

You must have submitted your quarantine plan in advance via the iCent app to Canadore prior to your departure from your home country.

You must self-isolate for 14 days, and the iCent app will have information to help you identify options for hotels, airport pick-up and meal packages.

International Student Ambassadors will be assigned to international students to help with coordinating travel to and from the assessment centre for COVID-19 testing, and will do daily check-ins if students require any support.

You must complete a COVID-19 test between 5 and 7 days upon your arrival, at the closest assessment centre to your quarantine location. This is the only time you can leave quarantine, and you must travel directly to and from the testing centre.

A COVID-19 test can be arranged by working with your International Student Ambassador, or by calling the nearest COVID self-assessment Centre to your quarantining location:

Campus Access Information:

Once a negative COVID test result is received and submitted, **and the 14-day quarantine period is completed**, you will receive an invitation to attend campus. **You will be refused access to Canadore**

campuses if you have not received this authorization that all of the necessary steps have been completed.

Failure to follow these steps will result in you being denied access and any breaches in quarantine is reportable to authorities. The only time in which quarantine can be broken is to access required medical supports such as conducting the COVID test at an assessment centre.

Information for programs delivered fully online

If your program is delivered fully online, it is expected that you will have minimal requirement to be on campus. Please note that Open Computer labs will not be available this fall.

Student/Staff IDs begin with A00, 19 and 20, are between 7-8 characters in length, and can be found on your Student Card/Registration Documents.

Self Service PIN: If this is your **first login**, your **PIN** is your date of birth in **ddmmyy** format

iLearn Login: Username is your student number: e.g. A00123456, Password is your date of birth in the format DDMMYY
