Lunar New Year 2023 – Year of the Rabbit

January 22nd, 2023, marked the beginning of the year of the Rabbit. Lunar New Year is one of the most important holidays in China and is also celebrated in countries with significant overseas Sinophone populations, including Vietnam, Singapore, Indonesia, Malaysia, Myanmar, Thailand, Cambodia, and the Philippines to mark the beginning of a calendar year whose months are based on lunar cycles.

The Lunar New Year festival was traditionally a time to honor deities as well as ancestors. Within China, regional customs and traditions concerning the celebration of the New Year vary widely, and the evening preceding the New Year's Day is frequently regarded as an occasion for Chinese families to gather for an annual reunion dinner. It is also traditional for every family to thoroughly clean their house, in order to sweep away any ill-fortune and to make way for incoming good luck.

STUDY IN CANADA

Transition Period for Distant Learning

Canada welcomes international students to return, as it is slowing drifting towards the pre-pandemic standards.

The length of time accrual for a Post-Graduate Work Permit (PGWP) varies depending on the start date of a student's study program.

It should be highlighted that, international students are required to complete at least 50% of their program in Canada for those students whose program began between September 1, 2022 and August 31, 2023.

However, this does not mean that students need to be physically present in the community in which their classes are being delivered, simply that they do need to be in Canada.

In other words, international students at Canadore College may continue to study remotely from within Canada, as long as they are physically present in Canada for 50% of their studies.

Canadore College is presently hosting two students from Puebla, Mexico for Winter 2023 as a part of the Emerging Leaders in the Americas Program for the Winter 2023 Intake (ELAP).

It's Tax Season

Tax season is here and many of you are likely eager to do your taxes. Please note your T2202A Tax Forms will be available in your Self-Serve account.

Please note this tax season is to assess the year 2022. Forms for 2022 and years previous (2021, 2020, etc.) will be the only ones available at this time. 2022 forms will be available at next tax season (this time next year).

To retrieve your forms, please follow these instructions:

- Log into your student self-serve (If you have any log in difficulty, please follow instructions provided on the login screen);
- 2. Once logged in, click on the "Student" tab at the top (beside "Personal Information")
- 3. Now click Canadian Tax Forms;
- 4. Choose T2202A Tax Credit Form;
- 5. Now choose the 2022 option in the dropdown menu (or whichever previous year you are having assessed);
- 6. Ensure the "Printable T2202A Form (PDF)" is selected;
- 7. Click "Submit".
- 8. The form should download.

**If you have issues with the download, try using a different browser (i.e., if you are using Google Chrome, use Explorer instead and vice versa).
