Subject: Coming to Canada: Applying for your Visa

Hello incoming international students!

To kick us off, here is the information you need to get your PAL and apply for your study permit.

How to Get Your Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL)

To receive your Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL), please follow these steps:

- 1. **Pay Your First Semester Fees in Full**: Complete your first semester payment to Canadore College. See <u>How do I pay my fees</u>?
- 2. **Payment confirmation:** Once we confirm your payment we will then request your PAL directly from the Province.
- 3. Timeline for Receiving Your PAL:
 - From payment confirmation to receiving your PAL: approximately 5-10 business days
- 4. **Receive Your PAL Notification**: When your PAL is ready, we will upload it to your OCAS application under "Supporting Documents," and you will receive a notification.
- 5. Important note: You must apply for your study permit before January 21, 2025.

We typically aim to provide your PAL within 10 business days of submission; however, your full first semester fees must be paid in full before we can request the PAL from the Province. It is your responsibility to see the cost breakdown on page two of your LOA. If you deferred to a future term, there will be an increase in the cost due to inflation and it will need to be paid in full to get the PAL.
