## **Subject: Coming to Canada: What You Need to Know for Travel**

As you prepare for your journey to Canada, here's what you need to know:

Book your flights only <u>after</u> your visa is approved to avoid unnecessary expenses. Check your ticket or the airline's website for baggage allowances and ensure your passport is valid with enough pages. Always carry your original passport with you.

Keep important documents, medications, and a power bank in your carry-on bag, which must not exceed 7kg. No liquids over 100 ml are allowed. Check the <u>CBSA website</u> for detailed information on allowable items.

## **Important Note About Enrollment Letters**

Enrollment letters are <u>not</u> available until you've registered and begin attending classes. You <u>do not</u> require an enrollment letter for travel.

## **Required Travel Documents**

When you arrive in Canada, you'll meet a border services officer who will make sure you meet some basic requirements including the documents you may require for travel. ## **Transportation to North Bay or Parry Sound**

If you land at Toronto Pearson Airport: you can use Ontario Northland buses or Northern Airport Service vans to reach North Bay or Parry Sound.

If you land at Jack Garland Airport (within North Bay): you can use Uride, Taxi 5-0 (705 476-5050), or U Need a Cab (705 497-7777) to get to your accommodations.

**Note**: the Ontario Northland and Airport Service can be reserved ahead of time.
