

BUS TRANSIT ETIQUETTE



PRIORITY SEATING

Individuals with disabilities must be given priority seating. Do not sit in accessible seating. Please keep the aisle clear and avoid standing in front of accessible seating areas.



COURTESY SEATING

Seniors, pregnant individuals, or others in need must be given courtesy seating.



OFFER ASSISTANCE

Allow those who are struggling to board the bus first. Offer to help if you can do so safely. Do not push people out of the way.



BE READY

Have your digital bus pass loaded and ready before boarding the bus.



MOVE TO REAR

If the bus is crowded, move to the back & allow others to get on.



DON'T BLOCK AISLES

Allow easy boarding and exits by moving away from doors. Don't block aisles. Ensure aisles are clear of obstruction such as bags, parcels, strollers, etc.



EXIT AT THE REAR

Exit the bus by the rear door whenever possible, exercising caution.

BE MINDFUL OF NOISE

Keep conversations quiet. Use headphones to decrease noise levels.



NO OBJECTS ON SEATS

When other passengers need a place to sit, please put your bags in your lap.



NO PROFANITY

The use of foul language is not acceptable on public transit.



BE COURTEOUS AND RESPECTFUL

No littering and no feet on seats.



NO PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

Alcohol, drugs, smoking and vaping are all strictly prohibited on public transit and in all transit shelters.



COVER YOUR MOUTH IF YOU SNEEZE OR COUGH

This helps to reduce the risk of spreading illness to others.
