

COVID-19 Update – June 14, 2022

Ontario lifted most of its remaining mask mandates on Saturday, June 11, 2022, including hospitals and public transit. Masking will remain mandatory in long-term care and retirement homes.

Canadore College continues to follow the guidance of local and provincial health authorities and will continue to maintain its COVID-19 mask mandate until Thursday, June 30, 2022, at which time it will <u>pause</u> its facial covering requirements.

Canadore strongly encourages our campus community to wear a mask when indoors or in close proximity to others even after its mask mandate has been paused. The College will continue to provide free face masks for those who wish to wear them. Masks will be available at the main entrances of each campus and can be made available to departments.
