



Electrical Techniques

Dual Credits: two high school credits and two college courses

Residential Theory I – TNN4T (College Course: ELE110)

This course introduces students to residential electrical wiring. Students will learn proper terminology, basic principles and wiring practices, based on the Ontario Electrical Safety Code.

Electrical Practical – TNO4T (College Course: ELE120)

The learners will be introduced to the electrical practical environment where they will learn and demonstrate the safe operation and use of trade tools and equipment. Students will demonstrate installation procedures for a 100-amp residential consumer's service. This course also includes an introduction to wiring receptacles, switches and lights.

Note:

- Tuition, materials and transportation fees will be covered through the Dual Credit program.
- All students are expected to attend an orientation session prior to taking part in any Dual Credit program.
- Students will be contacted by the Dual Credit Program Assistant, at least one week prior to the start of the program, to be provided with a date, time and location for each orientation session.
