Results

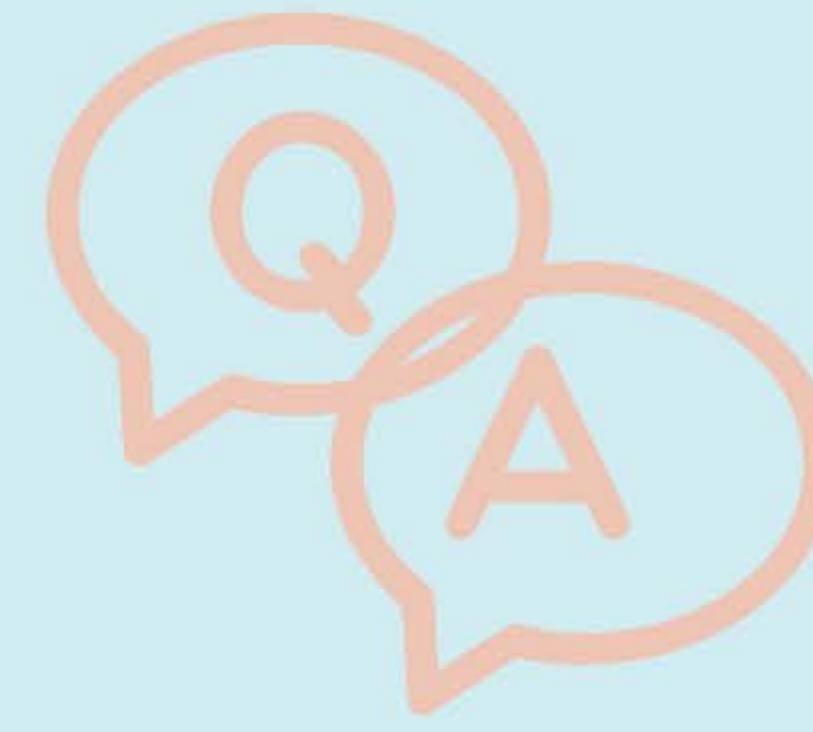
