Deferral Process

Deferral requests for Winter 2022 will be accepted until December 27, 2021 to ensure applications remain active for the upcoming cycle. Canadore will now only permit one (1) deferral request per student. Once that step has been exhausted, agents will have to re-initiate the application process and apply on the student's behalf with a new application and supporting documents along with a new \$100.00 application fee via the OCAS system.

All new offers issued via a deferral request must be accepted and proof of payment uploaded once again. These steps must be taken every time a new offer is issued. If proof of payment is not uploaded, the student will not be able to register nor request a deferral/refund.

Deferrals vs. Withdrawals

Please note that deferral requests after registration are not considered deferral requests. Agents, on behalf of the student, are required to withdraw the application as per the process and re-apply. The re-application fee of \$100.00 will apply.

If a student does not attend class, it is the student's responsibility to withdraw, not the agent. Agents are encouraged to advise students of the process. Please direct students to the program withdrawal form: EmailMe Form - Program Withdrawal





Registration

Once an agent confirms a student's program choice in OCAS and the student has registered, agents on behalf of students agree to the terms of our refund policy. As per the refund policy, if a student provides visa refusal evidence <u>prior</u> to the 10-day count, they are subject to a holdback of \$300.00. <u>After</u> the 10-day count, there is no refund.

Only fees paid in advance for subsequent terms of study will be refunded.

If the student has registered for the program, they are required to also fill out the Program Withdrawal Form. The form must be completed <u>prior to the last day</u> of withdrawal to qualify for any refunds.

Refund Instructions

If the student has registered, they must first withdraw from the program of study; see the section above for more information.

- All refund requests are initiated through the OCAS Portal. You will receive automatic email responses from the OCAS site when we are approving your refund. For this reason, duplicate requests sent directly to Canadore College will not be responded to.
- **CLICK HERE** for our full refund policy. A \$300.00 administrative fee is withheld for Visa refusals (with proof) provided it is received <u>prior to the 10th day of class</u>. For your students withdrawing before the 10th day of class (with no proof of Visa refusal), we withhold the formula method in the amount of \$2,422.49 for the 2021-2022 academic year. No refunds are given for withdrawals after the 10th day of class.

If students are not sure they will register for the upcoming term and plan to defer, agents are requested to advise student <u>not to register</u> until a final determination is made by the student. Semester fees are automatically applied immediately upon registration.

The refund process may take 6 to 8 weeks.

Post-Graduate Work Permit Extension

The Post-Graduation Work Permit Program (PGWP) allows students who have graduated from eligible Canadian designated learning institutions (DLIs) to obtain an open work permit to gain valuable Canadian work experience.

Temporary measures put in place by the Government of Canada to extend international students' eligibility for PGWPs while studying online has been <u>extended to December 31, 2021</u>.

These measures will assist international students by ensuring that studies completed outside Canada will count towards a future PGWP and by allowing international students to complete their entire program online from abroad and still be eligible for a PGWP. These measures apply to all international students who are enrolled in a PGWP-eligible program and meet all other PGWP criteria. Definition of Partial Delivery vs. Full Delivery

Fully = Full remote delivery, onsite presence not required

Partially = A combination of remote and physical activities, onsite presence required for part of the course

None = Full onsite delivery

Arrival Dates Timelines

Agents can add value to their services by providing students with expected arrival date as stated in the student's Letter of Acceptance (LOA).

Geographical Entrance Awards

Canadore offers Geographical Entrance Incentives for registered international students who originate from Africa, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Central and South America, Eastern Europe, Indonesia/Malaysia, Morocco, Nepal, Pakistan, Philippines, Senegal, Sri Lanka and Vietnam.

Program Incentives

From time to time, Canadore College will introduce program incentives. These are determined typically between February and May annually. We anticipate having an update in our May 2022 Semester update.

Scholarships and Bursaries

Did you know that International students are eligible to apply for entrance awards, bursaries, scholarships and external awards? We invite you and your students to view these opportunities on our website: Entrance Awards - Canadore College. Scholarships are based on a combination of academic excellence, attendance and overall contribution to the classroom. Applications are open annually from November 1st and closes on December 17th at 4:00 p.m. Recipients will be notified by email in March. External awards are often offered in other countries. We encourage agents to source out this information to assist students.

COVID-Related

Mandatory Vaccine and Quarantine: **Effective October 15, 2021,** Canadore College requires all students, employees, visitors and contractors coming to any campus be fully vaccinated, including College Drive, Aviation and Commerce Court in North Bay as well as West Parry Sound campus.

Here is what you need to know:

- All students, employees, visitors, and contractors coming onto a Canadore campuses must attest to their COVID-19 vaccination status;
- The College will require proof of vaccination status beginning October 29, 2021; Anyone not fully vaccinated will not be granted access to any Canadore College Campus as of October 29, 2021;
- Exemptions for medical or religious grounds protected under the Ontario Human Rights Code will be considered with the proper documentation; Those with approved
 International Students

documentation; Those with approved exemptions will be required to conduct regular rapid antigen COVID-19 testing.

As an agent, you can prepare international students for their travels to Canada. All visitors to Canada need to satisfy the Canadian Government that students will adhere to strict quarantine requirements. Please note a quarantine plan is mandatory for all students coming to Canada regardless of vaccination status. However, students who qualify may be fully exempt from quarantine as noted here.

Quarantine Help Desk

Given the public health requirements that international students are subject to, Canadore College has a dedicated team of student

International Students Who Plan to Travel to Canada Must Follow These Steps:

- 1. Submit their isolation plan via iCent;
- Request the travel support letter: EmailMe Form
 Travel Support Letter Request Form;
- 3. Have their plan approved and receive the travel support;
- 4. Upload their proof of vaccination via the ArriveCan app as indicated by the government of Canada here;
- Travel as planned and share information (such as the isolation plan and travel support letter) with the border officer if/when requested;
- 6. Await decision from CBSA at the border as to whether they must continue to their quarantine place or if they are exempted from quarantine.

**IMPORTANT: Canadore College and the Quarantine team cannot confirm whether a student will be exempted. This decision can only made by the appropriate authority such as a CBSA Border Officer.

Late Arrivals and Course Changes

Canadore received a few international students at the beginning of October 2021 at our main campus for Fall 2021 Intake. Canadore is committed to the academic delivery dates and deadlines. Agents are not permitted to advise students that they have the option to switch a program once they arrive in Canada and Canadore College. It is unfortanate that a student's academic success is at risk due to this advice. As situations arise, we will follow-up with the agency as appropriate.

Agent partners are not permitted to switch programs after the the student application has been submitted if a program is full. A note will be left in the OCAS Portal to indicate an alternate choice by our International Admissions Team.

As an approved agent with Canadore College, our expectation of agents are high and we will be monitoring agency performance to measure our partnership. We remind all agents to review all important dates and deadline as stipulated on our website Important Dates and Deadlines - Canadore College and read all important information sent by Canadore College.


Agency Spotlight
