ICENT APP



Program delivery update: COVID-19 - Travel restriction measures

Instructions have been modified to align with the coming into force of Phase 3 of the Border Reopening plan on September 7, 2021. This includes an operational plan to process temporary resident visas.

The border measures:

- keep the existing travel restrictions for entry
- permit discretionary travel from foreign nationals who meet the fully vaccinated exemption

Exemption letters for immediate family members of temporary residents and for extended family members of Canadian citizens, persons registered as Indians under the Indian Act and permanent residents have been updated to remove references to the 3-night hotel stopover requirement for air travellers and adjust the reference to quarantine requirements for fully vaccinated foreign nationals.

- Electronic travel authorization (eTA): COVID-19 program delivery
- Temporary resident visas (TRVs): COVID-19 program delivery

Beware of scams using false CBSA credentials

The Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) is warning the public about ongoing email, web, text messages and telephone scams in which people posing as officials from the CBSA are asking for payment or personal information, including Social Insurance Number (SIN). The methods and messages used by the scammers are varied and everchanging, but always designed to demand money and lure the public into providing personal information.

In some cases, these scams use false CBSA information. Telephone calls may display numbers and employee names that falsely appear to be from the CBSA. Emails may contain CBSA logos, email addresses or employee names and titles to mislead the public.

The CBSA never initiates a request for social insurance number and credit card number by telephone or email. If an individual receives a telephone call or an email asking for this information, or requesting payments from the CBSA, it is a scam. If this happens, please ignore, hang up, don't answer the text or email and report the incident to the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre.

The public should look out for fraudulent webpages and mobile applications posing as <u>ArriveCAN</u> or the Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) and asking for money. ArriveCAN is free and secure and is the official Government of Canada platform to provide your mandatory information before and after entering Canada. An application for an Electronic Travel Authorization can only be made and paid for through the <u>official Government of Canada website</u>. An eTA is electronically linked to a traveller's passport and costs \$7 CAD.

It is important to be vigilant. These calls, emails, and other forms of fraud should be ignored and reported to the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre.

Program delivery update: Temporary Resident table of contents and Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA) exemption code table

The table of contents for temporary residence program delivery instructions (PDIs) has been updated to reflect some name changes of the PDIs and to add in new PDIs that were recently developed.

The Labour Market Impact Assessment (LMIA) exemption code table has been updated to add in LMIA exemption codes that were developed in the last year.

MANDATORY VACCINE AND QUARANTINING

Canadore College requires that all students, employees, visitors and contractors coming to any campus be fully vaccinated. This mandate affects all Canadore campuses – College Drive, Aviation, and Commerce Court in North Bay as well as West Parry Sound.

Here is what you need to know:

- All students, employees, visitors, and contractors coming onto a Canadore campuses must attest to their COVID-19 vaccination status;
- It is expected that all students and employees will have at least their first dose of a Health Canada approved vaccine by the first day of Fall Semester;
- Exemptions for medical or religious grounds protected under the Ontario Human Rights Code will be considered with the proper documentation; and
- Those with approved exemptions will be required to conduct regular rapid antigen COVID-19 testing. For more information click here.

International Students Who Plan to Travel to Canada Must Follow These Steps:

- 1. Submit their isolation plan via iCent;
- 2. Request the travel support letter: <u>EmailMe Form Travel Support Letter Request Form</u>;
- 3. Have their plan approved and receive the travel support;
- 4. Upload their proof of vaccination via the ArriveCan app as indicated by the government of Canada here;
- 5. Travel as planned and share information (such as the isolation plan and travel support letter) with the border officer if/when requested;
- Await decision from CBSA at the border as to whether they must continue to their quarantine place or if they are exempted from quarantine.

**IMPORTANT: Canadore College and the Quarantine team cannot confirm whether a student will be exempted. This decision can only made by the appropriate authority such as a CBSA Border Officer.

If you are an international student that intends to travel to Canada soon, please be reminded that you will need to satisfy the Canadian Government that you will adhere to strict quarantine requirements. **Please note a quarantine plan is mandatory for all students coming to Canada regardless of vaccination status.**However, students who qualify *may* be fully exempt from quarantine as noted here. Please find steps for travel to Canada in the red box above.

QUARANTINE HELPDESK AT CANADORE COLLEGE

Given the public health requirements that international students are subject to, Canadore College has set-up a dedicated team of advisors to assist international students with their travel and quarantine needs. HEALTH INSURANCE

All International Students at Canadore College benefit from inclusion in a health insurance plan. For the health and safety of our students and community this is mandatory and included as part of international students' ancillary fees.

Pregnancy and Pre-existing Conditions

It is important for international students to be made aware that pregnancy-related expenses may or may not be covered by their health insurance policy. This depends, largely, on the coverage start date for the student.

If a student is pregnant prior to the start date of the policy, their condition may be considered 'pre-existing'*. If this is the case, pregnancy-related expenses may not be covered by the health insurance plan.

*Please note that a Pre-Existing Condition that was not stable in the 90 days immediately before Your Effective Date is not covered. This includes pregnancy before you arrive in Canada and any other medical condition which you knew you would need to or caused you to seek medical advice, diagnosis, care or Treatment in the 90 days before your effective date.


