Special Events for International Students

Winter 2021 'Live' International Student Orientation

The International Department organized a special, live, International Student Welcome Orientation Event on February 1, 2021 from noon to 1pm. All new and returning international students were welcome to attend and notice was sent to students via email.

During this session, hosted by the International Department at Canadore College, we touched on matters such as immigration (including the Rural and Northern Immigration Pilot Program), health insurance, student services, and provided an introduction to the city and community of North Bay. We also had representatives from the local Chamber of Commerce and Multicultural Centre present to speak to our students.

Special Immigration Session for Canadore International Students

On January 19, 2021, Canadore College was pleased to offer a webinar for our international students on immigration-related matters. We invited Elizabeth Long, an immigration lawyer from Long Mangalji LLP, to present via webinar on topics such as maintaining status, conditions of working legally on and off-campus,

iCent App

A good place for international students to start their introduction to Canadore College and to the vibrant community of North Bay is the iCent App. Use of the iCent App is mandatory for international students at the College.

The iCent app includes access to the International Student Guide, links to our comprehensive FAQs, information on financial aid and student supports, student health insurance, and is also an important mechanism through which international students can receive important messages directly from the institution.

In other words, the iCent app is your one-stop-shop for all matters relevant to international students at Canadore College.

Immigration updates

Post-Graduate Work Permit Extension

The Post-Graduation Work Permit Program (PGWPP) allows students who have graduated from eligible Canadian designated learning institutions (DLIs) to obtain an open work permit to gain valuable Canadian work experience. On February 12, 2021, temporary measures put in place by the Government of Canada to extend international students' eligibility for PGWPs while studying online has been extended till December 31, 2021.

These measures will assist international students by ensuring that studies completed outside Canada will count towards a future PGWP, and by allowing international students to complete their entire program online from abroad and still be eligible for a PGWP. The measures apply to all international students who are enrolled in a PGWP-eligible program, and meet all other PGWP criteria. Restoration of Status

The public policy to allow individuals who have lost their temporary residence status after January 30, 2020 to restore their status has been extended to August 31, 2021. Instead of the normal 90-day restoration period, an individual who had valid temporary resident status on or after January 30, 2020 but whose status expired on or before May 31, 2021, and have remained in Canada since, will have until August 31, 2021 to submit their restoration application

Travelling to Canada and Quarantining

If you are an international student that is presently studying online but intends to travel to Canada in the near future, there are several matters you should be aware of. First and foremost, among these is the need to abide by strict quarantine rules.

Canadore College has implemented robust measures related to quarantining. These involve adhering to public health guidelines (federal, provincial and college guidelines). International students that seek to attend classes at Canadore College must be aware of the following:

Quarantine Steps

- You must submit an isolation plan via the iCent App which will be reviewed and approved by the International Dept at Canadore College;
- Successful submission of a quarantine plan will result in the release of a travel support letter;
- Beginning on February 22, 2021, in addition to the need to quarantine for a mandatory 14 days (which
 has been place in Canada for over six months), there is also now a requirement for travelers to first
 book a stay in an approved hotel for 3 days during which time a student/traveler will be tested before
 being released to complete the remaining 11 days of their quarantine in accordance with an approved
 quarantine/isolation plan
