Why the PechaKucha format?


This way all of the teams will have equal opportunity to pitch by having the same template and expectations (Amy and Phoebe will tell you more in a few minutes).

- We understand that some teams might have graphic design and presentation sills that are a bit more advanced than others. This keeps the teams on an equal playing field for the pitch itself.
- Time was also a concern, PechaKucha will keep all the presentations will be 6:40 in length.





Teams will be presenting in a PechaKucha format. This is a presentation format where a speaker presents 20 slides, each displayed for 20 seconds, for a total presentation time of 6 minutes and 40 seconds. The slides automatically advance while the presenter speaks, creating a fast-paced and concise presentation style.
