Dual Credits: two high school credits and Level 1 Apprenticeship Automotive Service Technician

Automotive Service Technician – TTE4Y (College Course: 310S) Level 1 In-school Curriculum

Apprentices can expect to become familiar with inspections, diagnoses, repairs, and services to mechanical, electrical, and electronic systems and components of cars, buses, and trucks.

This is a theory-based course; students taking this program should either have already taken co-operative education in a related field or be currently involved with an employer.

Note:

- Tuition, materials, equipment and transportation fees will be covered through the Dual Credit program.
- All students are expected to attend an orientation session prior to taking part in any Dual Credit program.
- Students will be contacted by the SCWI Program Assistant, at least one week prior to the start of the program, to be provided with a date, time and location for each orientation session.
- Delivery: Day release (one day per week from September until June) to complete the program-required 240 hours.
- Students involved in this program will be excused from their regular classes or co-op to attend the College.
