

## CSU International Programs

CSU International Programs (CSU IP) are offered at more than 50 distinguished universities in 18 countries for the semester, academic or calendar year. Students apply from all 23 campuses in the CSU system. You pay CSU tuition, may use Financial Aid (if eligible), and receive CSULB credit.

Requirements for this program are generally a **2.75 GPA** (some countries require a **3.0 GPA**). Students may study in English in most locations and many are open to sophomores. Other programs require 2 years of a foreign language and junior class standing. Learn more details at: www.calstate.edu/ip

#### Why study abroad for a year?

CSU IP's guiding principle is that students should be "immersed" in the academic and living environments of their host countries. Your life will be transformed by learning a new language and culture.

Employers want "real world" experience. By studying abroad you gain international skills and global understanding. Your future employer will value your ability to look at things from different points of view.

#### Is it expensive?

No. Costs are comparable to studying at CSULB and, in some cases, may even be lower. Financial aid applies.



The following countries have an annual application deadline of October 1, require a 3.0 GPA, and run from February - December.

Since study in most of these countries is available only for certain majors, be sure to visit the Study Abroad Office for academic advising to see which site matches your major! In addition to the CSU IP application, you will need two faculty letters of recommendation, official transcripts from all previous college work, and a passport.

### CSULB Semester Programs

CSULB offers one-semester or one-year programs (<u>Direct Exchanges</u>) with 58 partner universities for either the fall or spring semester. You enroll full-time at CSULB, pay regular CSULB tuition, may use Financial Aid (if eligible), and receive CSULB credit. For most locations, the cost of living is the same as or less than living in southern California.

The requirements for these programs are generally a **2.75-3.0 GPA** and **Sophomore/Junior/Senior** class standing. Deadlines for applying are **October 1st for spring and March 8th for fall**. All applicants must complete the on-line CSULB Direct Exchange application, submit 2 faculty recommendations and official transcripts from all college work.

#### **CSULB London Semester**

CSULB London Semester is offered every spring (in partnership with CSU Fullerton). Courses are taught in London, England by CSULB and CSUF faculty and open to sophomore/junior/senior students with a minimum 2.6 GPA. You pay CSULB tuition and may use your Financial Aid. A 3-unit internship related to your major is optional. Required Course:

C/LA 305 British Life & Culture (3 units) CR/NC Team-taught by British faculty

#### **CSULB Florence Semester**

CSULB Florence Semester is offered every fall (in partnership with CSU Fullerton). Courses are taught in Florence, Italy by CSULB and CSUF faculty and open to sophomore/junior/senior students with a minimum 2.6 GPA. You pay CSULB tuition and may use your Financial Aid. A 3-unit internship related to your major is optional. Required Course:

ITAL 101A (4 units) Taught by Italian faculty (Students who have completed ITAL 101A may take an optional course.)

**CSULB Costa Rica Semester** 

CSULB Costa Rica Semester is offered every spring. Courses are taught in San José, Costa Rica by CSULB faculty and open to sophomore/junior/senior students with a minimum 2.5 GPA. You pay CSULB tuition and may use your Financial Aid. A 3-unit internship related to your major is optional.
