

Health Resource Guide

Due to the high cost of U.S. medical care, California State University, Long Beach (CSULB) requires all international F-1 and J-1 visa students to enroll in health insurance coverage in order to avoid the threat to the financial obligations uninsured students face.

In addition, CSULB requires all full-time new students to show proof of immunity within the first semester of classes. Receiving clearance of the CSULB immunization requirement ensures that you remain a healthy adult and that you protect everyone else, too!

*If you remain uninsured and uncleared of your immunization requirements, you may face consequences that can affect your enrollment and immigration status.



What is 'Health Insurance'? Health Insurance is a paid plan that helps with the cost of medical care bills. Examples of medical care are doctors' appointments, urgent care visits, and prescribed medications.

At the ALI, health insurance enrollment is offered through JCB Insurance Solutions (Insurance Broker) and coverage is provided by Anthem Blue Cross (Plan - Custom Classic PPO).

What are 'Immunizations'? Immunizations are a way of protecting your body against infection or disease through a vaccine(s) (substance that helps develop antibodies).

Enrollment and Eligibility

Enroll on-line at www.jcbins.com or contact a JCB Insurance Solutions representative at 562.263.5180. You may also receive enrollment assistance by the admissions team in the ALI office or during orientation.

Downloading your Medical ID Card - Electronic only

You may need to provide your Medical ID card or know your number to receive medical care. Your Medical ID card will be available on-line through the mobile app 3 weeks after enrolling in the plan. You'll receive an email from Anthem Student Advantage once your ID card is ready to download.

To obtain an electronic copy of your Medical ID Card, please visit www.anthem.com/register and register for a member account, or download the Sydney Health Mobile App to your mobile device. If you enrolled and did NOT use your official CSULB Student ID, and used something like your passport number, then you MUST call Anthem directly at (800) 888-2108 for your "assigned" student ID BEFORE you register to get your ID card. You can request a hard copy ID card by contacting Member Services at 1-800-888-2108.
