ARTS PLASTIQUES / ÉTHIQUE ET CULTURE RELIGIEUSE / FRANÇAIS, LANGUE SECONDE / UNIVERS SOCIAL

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS / MATHEMATICS

- Students should always have an English novel to read in class (from home or library)
- One (1) protractor (no hole in center)
- One (1) calculator (not scientific)
- One (1) sturdy 1-inch binder (blue)

BOTH CLASSES:

- One (1) package of 200 sheets lined, loose-leaf paper (thick suggested)
- Two (2) black permanent markers (fine point)
- Two (2) coloured permanent markers (fine point)
- Two (2) dry-erase markers (for personal use in class)
- Two (2) pencil cases (one for regular use; one for coloured pencils and markers)
- Coloured pencils (good-quality) / markers
- Pens (4 red, 4 blue, 2 green, 2 black)
- Pencils sharpened (good quality) adequate supply for the whole year (approx. 24-36)
- Four (4) erasers and two (2) pencil sharpeners
- Two (2) non-liquid correction tape dispenser (Wite out suggested)
- Three (3) highlighters (1 yellow, 1 blue, 1 green)
- One (1) hard plastic metric ruler (30 cm)
- One (1) pair of scissors
- Two (2) glue sticks

SCIENCE:

- One (1) large resealable plastic bag (i.e. Ziploc)
- One (1) 1-inch binder
- One (1) stitched exercise book; 32 pages (Hilroy Canada suggested)

OPTIONAL:

- One (1) large resealable plastic bag (i.e. Ziploc; for Science class)
- One (1) large resealable plastic bag (i.e. Ziploc; for extra supplies to be kept in homeroom or locker)
