Budget Cuts Announcement:

The CAQ government announced \$200 million in education cuts, with EMSB losing \$2.6 million by March. Department directors will determine specific reductions, but pedagogical budgets remain unaffected.

EMSB Annual Report and Success Rate:

The council approved the 2023-2024 Annual Report, highlighting EMSB's record 95.9% success rate. The new graduation target is 92%.

Budget Consultation and School Priorities:

The council approved the budget consultation, which will be sent to Governing Boards (GBs) and the Parents Committee for input on funding priorities.

<u>Supreme Court Challenge – Bill 21</u>: The Supreme Court of Canada will hear EMSB's legal challenge to Bill 21.

<u>Court Challenge — Bill 40:</u> The Court of Appeal has reviewed the Bill 40 challenge; a decision is pending.
