

John Grant high school students make, publish music video

Special-needs students from the Côte St. Luc-based John Grant High School have, under the guiding hand of recording artist and producer David Hodges, produced and published an original song and music video.

Last month, teacher Marie Francis invited Hodges to visit the school and, dur-

ing his two-day visit, he helped students produce the song titled “Breakthrough,” according to an English Montreal School Board (EMSB) press release.

The lyrics include lines like, “We’ve all been searching for a light in our souls cause we all feel alone.” The chorus includes sentiments such as, “Let your light become your saving grace ’cause every day

we can change.”

Teacher Catherine Rendell-Green created the video with students to accompany the song. John Grant is a special-needs high school for students who follow individualized education plans (IEPs).
