Alphabet Photo Dictionary

Home & Community Life

Students can use a parent's phone/ipad to take pictures of household/outdoor items for specific letters of the alphabet. The child can look for items that start with each letter around the house, in the backyard, or on a walk and take a picture of each item.

Option A: Match items found to the images. Alphabet list with photo match.

Option B: Have your child think of their own item and then take a picture, draw the item, or cut out images from a flyer/newspaper. Support your child as needed to write the word above their own image. Alphabet list (my own picture)



Describing

"Describing" is one of the essential communication skills. Talk about what people in the community are doing when you are taking a walk with your child. You can talk about what the characters are doing while watching a favorite TV show.



Option A: Open this package. Use the symbols to describe what the children in the photos are doing.

Option B: If your child can write short sentences, this is the package for you. Use the similar pattern "is - ing" to talk about people doing different things!

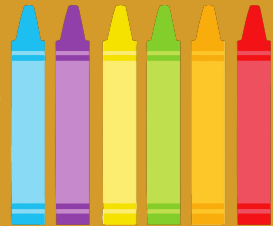


Drawing
