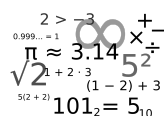

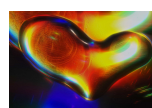

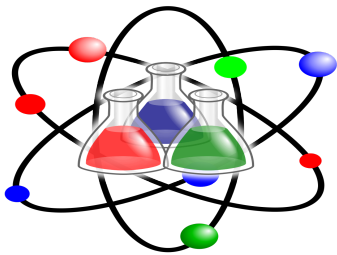


## Physical Education and Health

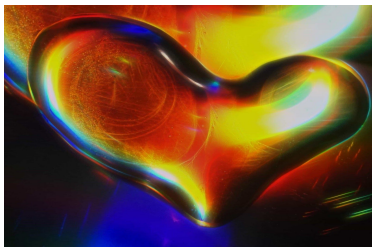
## Science & Technology
