Labeling child's belongings: We kindly request your assistance in ensuring that all of your child's personal belongings brought to school are clearly labeled with their name. Labeling these items helps us to quickly identify and return them to their rightful owner, minimizing the risk of loss and ensuring your child has everything they need for a smooth day at school.

Absences: As we are in the final term of the school year, we would like to take a moment to remind you of the importance of consistent attendance during this critical period for our students. Term 3 counts for 60% of their final result. The final term is essential for both academic progress and final preparation for end of year evaluations. Students will be reviewing important concepts, completing projects, and engaging in assessments that will shape their final performance.

Please keep in mind...

- **Attendance:** Regular and punctual attendance is crucial during this term. Missing school, especially in the final weeks, can significantly affect your child's understanding of key topics. Students that are absent are asked to see their teacher upon their return to school. Teachers are not expected to provide work when students are absent from school for un-motivated reasons.
- **End-of-Year Assessments:** Please ensure your child is present for any final exams, assessments, or projects. These play a vital role in their academic success. We encourage parents to contact teachers directly should they need further details.
- **Engagement:** Encourage your child to remain engaged and focused as we enter the final stretch. If your child is struggling, please do not hesitate to contact the administration, A strong finish helps set the tone for their continued success!
