If you are unable to attend, please email the teacher to schedule a different date and time.

It was created by an unofficial developer and allows student to connect to Mozaik, serving to reorganize the information it gets from Mozaik within the app. (Screen shot further below). We recommend that you and your children to only ever use sanctioned EMSB applications for school-related needs. This is of importance when using their EMSB credentials.

Health Tip for March

Bite into a fruit or vegetable

According to the Canadian food guide, in order for a child to eat healthy make half of his/her plate vegetables and fruits. Half a plate seems like a lot!!! Take a closer look, this quantity, distributed as a whole, is very easy to consume. Offer your child vegetables and fruits of different textures, colours and shapes.

- cauliflower
- mango
- spinach
- cantaloupe
- broccoli
- grapes
- sweet potatoes
- pineapple
- sweet peas
- strawberry



Vegetables and fruits frozen or canned without added sugar or seasoning is also a healthy option. You can add dried fruits as well (figs, cranberries, etc) to the plate.

Make the most of your meal; choose dark green and orange fruits and vegetables. These foods are very important for the fabrication of proteins and cells and they reinforce the immune system.
