Laurier Macdonald High School is an inclusive school with a variety of learners. Below is an overview of our academic programs and what they offer. Students who follow an Individualized Education Plan may register for any of the academic programs, provided they meet the eligibility requirements.

<p>Our Resource Program is part of the regular secondary school program mandated by the Quebec Education Ministry; however, it provides students with a smaller class size in English, French and Math. Students with particular special needs may qualify to enroll in this program, which runs from Secondary 1 to 3. An Individualized Education Plan is required.</p> <p>In Secondary 4 & 5, these students will integrate into our regular Core Program.</p>	<p>Our Core Program is part of the regular secondary school program mandated by the Quebec Education Ministry.</p> <p>Students in this program may still register for advanced and enriched options, if they meet the specific qualifications for those courses.</p>	<p>The Enriched IB/SÉBIQ Program is part of the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme and provides students with enriched level courses. It is intended for students who completed the IBPYP (Primary Years Programme) in elementary school and/or for those looking for a more rigorous academic profile.</p> <p>Students who graduate from The IB program will do so with more credits than their peers, setting them ahead of the competition for CEGEP applications. Students in IB also get a 2% increase on their R score when applying to SRAM CEGEPs and Marianopolis College.</p> <p>Students must successfully complete an entrance exam in order to be placed in the IB Program. Moreover, students must have a minimum average of 80% in English, French, Math and Science in their Grade 5 end-of-year report card.</p>
