In Flanders Fields

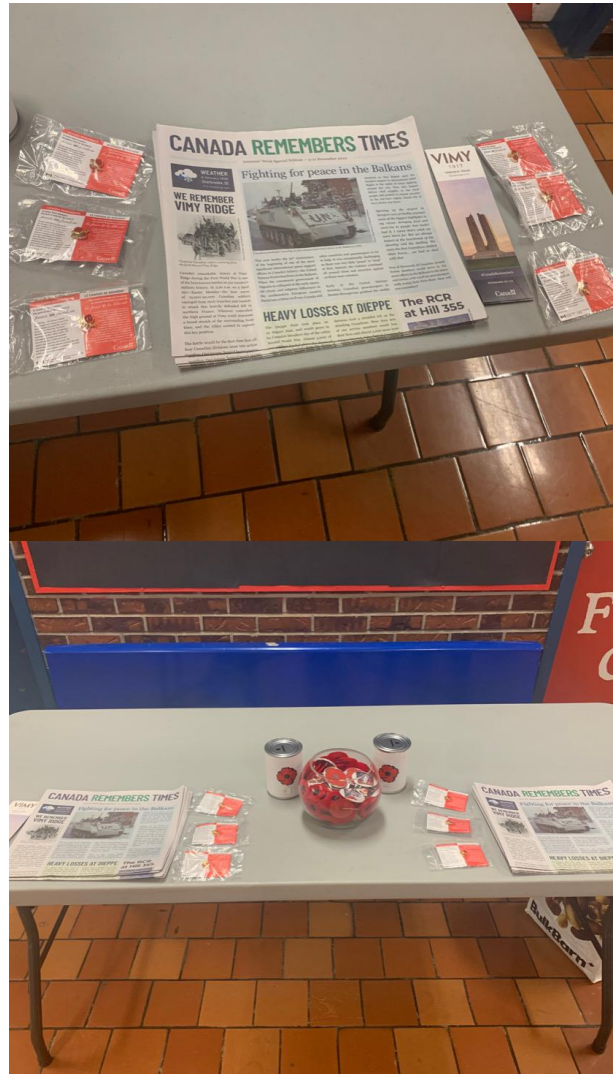
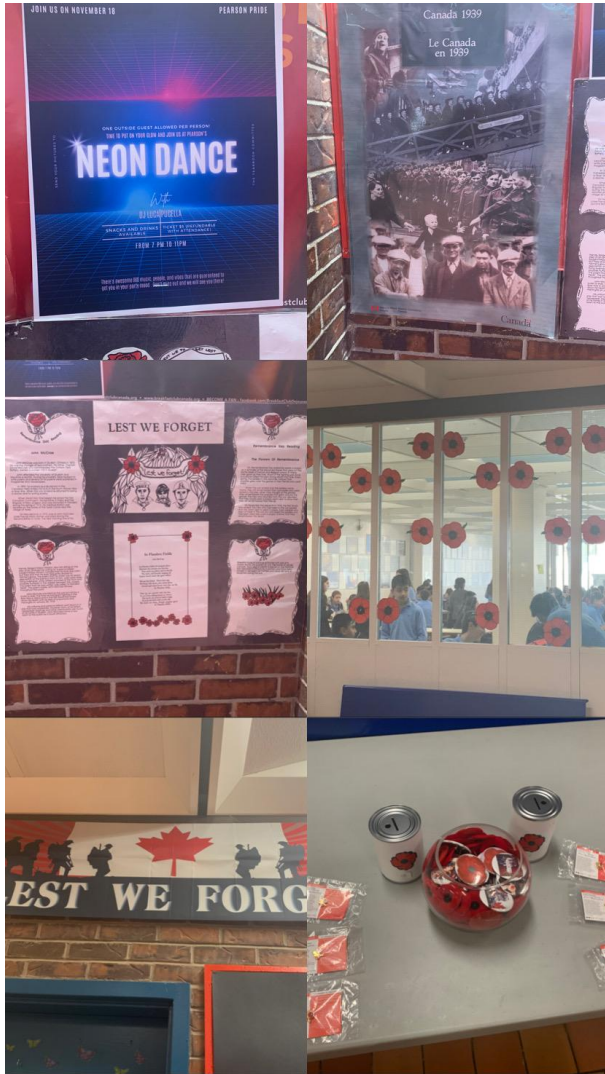
*In Flanders fields, the poppies blow
