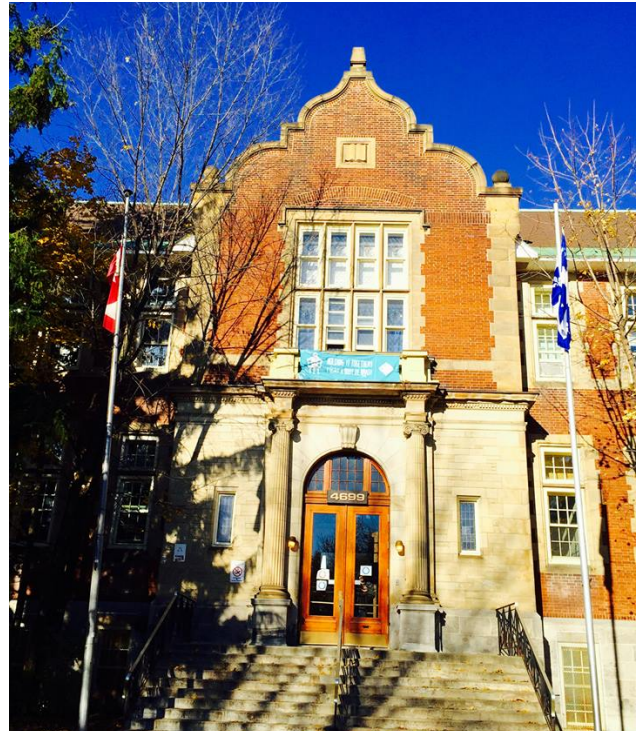
We hope that you and your

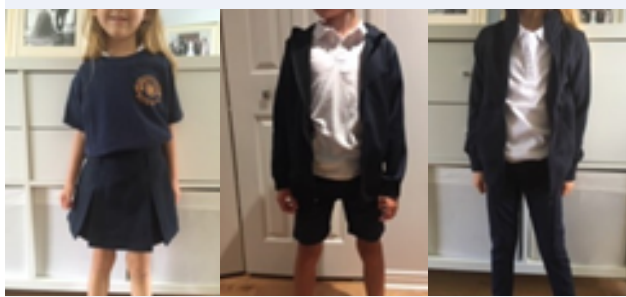

## SCHOOL DRESS CODE

### Permitted clothing:

- Solid navy blue or solid white or solid light blue top: blouse, shirt, t-shirt, turtleneck or polo  
OR navy-blue Roslyn Physical Education t-shirt
- Solid navy-blue bottoms: Plain navy-blue tunic, knee-length skirt, jogging pants, bermudas, leggings or cargo pants
- Solid navy-blue sweater: Plain solid navy-blue sweater, sweatshirt or cardigan

### Non permitted clothing:

- Different colored sweaters and tops with inappropriate language or symbols
- Different colored leggings with designs or jeans
- Spandex shorts or pants
- Mini-skirts, or skirts that are shorter than knee-length
- Tops with pictures, slogans and/or messages
- Crop tops, tank tops, halter tops and camisoles
- Rolled-up pants, ripped fringes
- Outdoor boots in the classroom
- High heels, platform shoes, running shoes with wheels, strapless and flip-flop sandals

## IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Cell phones are prohibited on school property and on the school bus (Page 21, Code of Conduct)
- Selfie-taking is also prohibited as this can lead to breach of privacy & cyber bullying.
