- 6. Breakfast program
 - Principal Lee: Breakfast Club of Canada, approved to start asap (see sample menu), objective is to reach as many kids as possible
 - o Contribution may be requested, school must decide how much
 - o If you want to exclude your child, you may
 - Meeting with reps from both campus in the next week to take a look at the logistics (is there enough space?)
 - Classroom bins will be used
 - Kids will eat as they get off the bus
 - Meeting with the teachers on the 17 (PED day) to discuss feeding logistics
 - Hope to get this going when we are back from March break
 - Everything is nut free, peanut free
 - Mouna question: I saw some kiwi allergies, maybe we should ask that there not be any
 - Melanie comment: I think it's great
 - Sophie question: I am happy that we are doing on both campuses. Should the contribution be per day and not per year?
 - o It is an opt out program and not an opt in program
 - We do not exclude a child if they don't contribute financially

o We already have the resolution from GB

7. Music and Art Therapy, all other programs of Hampstead

- Sophie: parent have asked how Music and Art Therapy programs can be brought to our school (Principal Lee had them implemented in his prior school)
- GI: These programs are in the works, should be implemented shortly (Art Therapy as a prevention for bullying is one of these programs, open by recommendations by the teacher), if it gets done, it will be 1 hour a week at each campus, it was also in place last year
- o Sophie: can these programs be put in place earlier in the year
- Principal David: budget come in later, usually around November (in his prior school, it was a teacher's initiative and not a formal therapy).
- The program is on teacher referral
- It is possible to divide by semester / recommendations / cycle
- Each program has its own ratio, logistics, etc.
- o A lot of clubs exist
- The only Therapy (not to be mistaken with Clubs) that we are in contact with: Art Therapy

8. Sugar Shack

- Dates: March 31st grade 4 6 (3 buses at each campus)
- April 2nd: PreK grand 3 (4 buses at each campus)
- Departure at 8:30, Leave at 1:30
- o Location: La Goudrelle
- o Free for students
- Parents can come, but they must pay the fee of approx. 15\$, we don't need parents, but they could be accepted, max 1 / campus

9. LD and ASD classes at North Campus

- When the campuses were split, it was planned that all LD and ASD classes be at south campus (correction by GI: ASD is at North campus and early stimulation is here)
- Early stimulation is not necessarily for students with autism, it is for those who need a boost, need play learning, ASD class (grade 1 – 6), maximum 7 students, for students coping with autism
- LD classes are at south campus (LD junior is grade 3-4, LD senior is 5-6, we don't put them in a special class, we want to give them all chances to succeed)
- \circ This year, ASD classes happen to have grades 1 3 (usually, they are split into junior and senior ASD, there is no senior this year)
- Each case is discussed with the families
- Because of lack of space, we could not open these classes at both campuses
- Request by Sophie: can we consider LD class at the North Campus
- Answer by Principal David: anything can be considered; however it is unlikely due to space issues (decision is made by special ed consultant)
- Every school in the west sector has space issues
- Asking Wendy = item 24 considered done. Wendy says that it answers all her questions.

- 10. Approval of extended day trip for grade 6 to Ottawa
 - Students will come back in the evening (approximately 8-8:30), won't make it to bus, because of this, we need GB approval
 - Resolution: Approval of the planning and participation of Grade 6 student's trip to
 Ottawa: they will come back after bus hours
 - David W. moves
 - Kathleen seconds
 - All for (unanimous)
- 11. Approval of time allocation to subjects
 - Approval of the allocation to subjects

 - ELA, Math and PE all schools should have the same. The rest is flexible as long as you respect certain minimums
 - Resolution: Keep status quo regarding subject time allocation for 2020-2021

- 13. School budget follow-up

 - We received the AMSFA for underprivileged schools as we ranked 8 (poverty index), we need to spend the money or we lose it (68 000 \$ + 5000 \$), currently left 70 000 \$
 - Trips approved: engage students / literacy
 - Open to ideas
