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4.2 Possible projects for next year (20 minutes)

Classe d'accueil in English and/or French

Mr. Iammarrone explained details around Classe d'accueil in English and/or French and the need for more French teaching support in school. Ms. Bel mentioned this needs to be further discussed and could be a long-term plan. Ms. Lesceault shared her opinions on this subject and a comparative view with other surrounding schools. Mr. Rony also shared his opinion on this and sees gradual changes could come in the future.

### • More support for 30% French instruction

Mr. lammarrone submitted his views on more support for 30% French instruction to the GB and that with Bill 96 in the pipeline this is an important aspect requiring considerations.

• Earlier information about high school options

Ms. Bel discussed the importance of earlier information about high school options to parent is key as a lot of parents need this information to be proactive and for making the right choices for their children and to know their options.

### Rationale for dress code

Ms.Bel submitted her thoughts on what the GB thought about the rationale for dress code in the school and encouraged a discussion on this subject. Mr. lammarrone explained various benefits of having a dress code as opposed to not having one. Mr. Rony echoed those thoughts and added that the benefits of having an affordable, loose and practical school dress code far outweighs that of not having one as it provides students with a sense of belonging, equality, responsibility, discipline amongst others. Ms. Marie and Mr. Lalli also shared the same message in favor of the school status quo on dress code.

#### 5.2 Teacher's Report

**Special Events** 

• Dynamix was at school on May 3 and 9 to run team-building activities. The weather was beautiful and all the students enjoyed themselves.

• Montreal musician Rob Lutes was at Westmount Park during the month of May to present a music writing workshop to cycle 3 students. This was in conjunction with The mental Health Resource Center in honor of youth mental health week.

• Our Green Club, under the leadership of Ms Christine, Ms Jennifer, Ms. Marie and parent volunteer Lisa Clarke created an Earth month calendar full of activities and events to promote environmental awareness. Events included a recycled art challenge, writing a letter to a tree, and weekly waste-free lunches. The students members of the group also recorded and presented public service announcements about recycling and composting.

• The Green Club will also be planting pollinator vegetables and herbs in the front of the school with the members of the club. This project is funded through the EMSB Go Green grant.


