


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Westmount Park School


- M. Alexiou stated how a Green Committee was set up with students.

Ms. Bel's regional parent committee report stated:

I was elected to the Executive Committee of the EMSB Parent Committee and am excited to represent WPS there and in continued work on the Anti-Racism subcommittee.

The Anti-Racism subcommittee had an emergency meeting in response to the death of an EMSB high school student, Jannai Dopwell-Bailey. He was a 16 year old Black boy, and he was murdered. It was not an accident or an illness. Many other students and staff of the school witnessed the murder. This changes the level of the trauma and the kind of support needed for this family, their school community, and the larger Black community. Program Mile End (Jannai's school) does not have a Governing Board. We are considering reaching out to other schools with particularly active GBs, including ours, to help this parent community.

There is an online school offered as a collaboration among many school boards including EMSB. Early feedback from parents is that it is not going well; it is not well-staffed and students are not receiving much work.

There is concern in the Anglophone community about the proposed curriculum change from ERC to Quebec Citizenship and Culture. We will be looking for more information about the content and opportunities to voice objections.

Green Committee

The WPS Green committee has initiated several programs to help promote a culture of sustainability in the school. We have begun a compost program for organic waste. We will be receiving reusable spoons from Breakfast Clubs of Canada and teachers are being encouraged to recycle all plastic waste created through the breakfast program. In addition, they are hoping to form a "Green Team" of students to collaborate on these initiatives.

Special Events

Classes participated in the first National Day for Truth and Reconciliation on September 30 to recognize the harm caused by Canada's residential school system and honour survivors.

The kindergarten team has continued their tradition of having a weekly kindergarten party to celebrate the letter of the week, while still respecting Covid guidelines.

Our behaviour techs.have started a leadership program in which grade 6 students animate games for younger students during recess. It has been quite successful to date.
