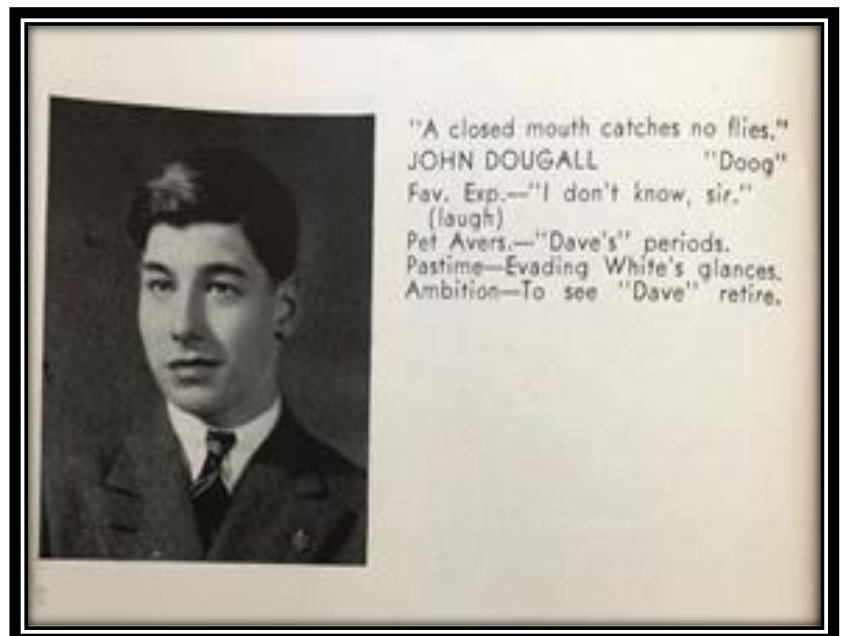

- He was killed because of a forced landing in Ottawa.

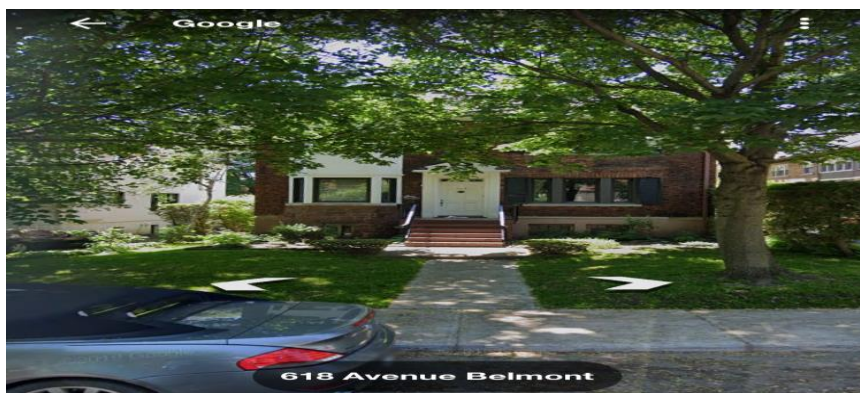
- He was buried at Montreal Cemetery (Mount Royal)
