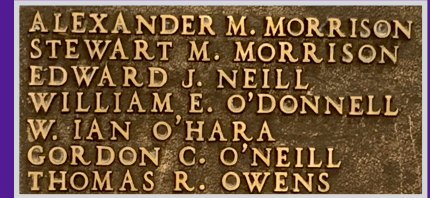




STEWART MACKENZIE MORRISON

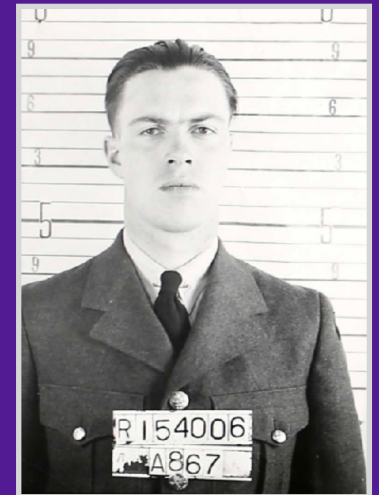


Stewart Mackenzie Morrison was born on August 23, 1919, in Lachine Québec and died November 26, 1942, near Low, Québec at the age of 23. He was the son of Hugh A. Morrison and Margaret Morrison, of Lachine. Morrison was a student of Westmount High School and graduated in 1936, a few years before the war broke out.

In the Royal Canadian Air Force, Morrison was a Leading Aircraftman, with pilot specialization, though he never fought in the war. In 1942, Morrison was involved in an aircraft accident during a training run with his instructor at the RCAF Service Flying Training School in Uplands, Ontario. Morrison was reported missing and presumed dead because the aircraft accident took place in the winter during which time neither the plane, nor the bodies could be found. A year later he was officially declared dead. He was buried at the Lake View Cemetery, Pointe Claire, Québec.
