## Non-Competition or Restrictive Covenant Policy #0.17

## I. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that KCU-GME Consortium residents/fellows will not be asked to sign a non-competition guarantee or restrictive covenant, pursuant to Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) Institutional Requirements.

## II. Policy Statement

The ACGME specifically prohibits the use of non-competition guarantees or restrictive covenants in resident/fellow agreements. Neither the sponsoring institution nor any of its ACGME-accredited training programs may require residents/fellows to sign a non-competition guarantee or restrictive covenant.

Residents/Fellows are advised that it is also improper to sign a non-compete/restrictive covenant clause in conjunction with any agreement of appointment.

## III. Procedure

Program directors must ensure that documentation required for signature by residents/fellows does not contain a non-compete or restrictive covenant clause.

Residents/Fellows must advise the KCU GME Department of any documents that contain language which could be construed as non-compete or restrictive covenant language.
