At McKesson ("McKesson" or "we"), we value the trust that pharmacies and patients place in us to appropriately use and protect personal information. This Privacy Notice informs users of McKesson's Health Mart Digital Portfolio about how McKesson may collect, use, and share personal information and how it is protected. PERSONAL INFORMATION WE MAY COLLECT

When you use this website and / or applications, we may collect personal information about you. Personal information is any information accessed, collected, or used by McKesson that identifies an individual, or can reasonably be used to identify an individual, whether directly or indirectly. The personal information we may collect includes, but is not limited to:

- First name, last name
- Date of birth, photographs/videos (such as through camera device or photo library application)
- Personal home address, personal telephone number (home, cell, fax, etc.), personal electronic mail address
- Medical history, Rx/prescription number, health insurance identification or account number, claims data and prescription information, therapies, medical products, or

equipment used, family health or morbidity history and other medical or health insurance information

- User ID and password
- Communication preferences such as text message or push notifications, email notification and frequency
- Geo-location/GPS information, device identification number/serial number (such as for mobile phone, tablet, or computer), browser type, computer or mobile device, device/User IP address, device/user activity (such as but not limited to: login-logout info, sites/pages visited, # of visits, click stream, navigation, beacon signal hits, errors, crash rate, or other user activities)
- Information about you that you share or make visible on the Internet. We may combine such information with information we already have about you.

TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES WE USE

We use various technologies to collect personal information about visitors to our websites and/or users of our websites and / or applications. These technologies include but are not limited to the following:

Web server logs

- As is true of most websites and applications, we gather certain information automatically and store it in log files. This information may include IP addresses, browser type, internet service provider, referring/exit pages, operating system, date/time stamp and/or clickstream data.
- We and our subsidiaries, business partners, marketing partners, affiliates, or other service providers may also use technologies such as: cookies and scripts. These technologies are used to remember your settings and to track your movement through our platforms. We may receive reports based on the use of tracking technologies from companies such as Google Analytics on an individual as well as aggregated basis. • Geo-location Services

- Other tracking technologies.

We also use local storage such as HTML5 to collect and store content information and preferences. Third parties who we partner with to provide certain features on our site or to display advertising use local storage such as HTML5 to collect and store information. Various browsers may offer their own management tools for removing HTML5 local storage.

HOW WE RESPOND TO "DO NOT TRACK" SIGNALS

Some web browsers have a "Do Not Track" feature. This feature allows you to tell websites you visit that you do not want to have your online activity tracked over time and across websites. - Your personal information will be shared with your Health Mart pharmacy to provide you the information, products and services that you may request. Your pharmacy has its own privacy practices and Health Mart has no control over or responsibility for your pharmacy's use of information that you may provide to it.

 - We may provide your personal information to third parties that provide services to help us with our business activities such as customer and troubleshooting support.
 These companies are authorized to use personal information about you only as necessary to provide these services to us.

- We may share your personal information we collect with Healthcare providers for appropriate administration of your healthcare.
- Some of our pages may utilize framing techniques to serve content to/from our partners while preserving the look and feel of the website and / or applications. Please be aware that you are providing personal information to these third parties and not directly to Health Mart. When framing techniques are utilized, your personal information is subject to the privacy practices of the third party.

Where permitted in our legitimate interest, or with your prior consent where required by law, we will use your name and email address to send health and wellness information to you.
