Mitsubishi Jet Towel Electric Hand Dryer

The touch-free Jet Towel electric hand dryer's strong air current (nearly 300 feet per second) removes water from the both sides of the hands in five to six seconds, according to the manufacturer. Users insert their hands to start the cycle, then slowly withdraw them, which turns off the fans. Water blown off the hands is collected in the unit's drain tank, keeping the floor dry. A timer automatically halts operation after 30 seconds to prevent misuse or abuse. The manufacturer provides explanatory stickers with simple instructions for first-time users. The total energy input per cycle is reputed to be 0.65kw. The noise level is 65 dB, considerably lower than some other electric hand dryers.
