2019 IMPACT EVALUATION

In January 2019, Kovacs Group developed an online evaluation to assess the impact of the P4P Planning Network. The survey link was sent to the 7000 registrants of the Planning Network Update List. No incentives were offered for participation in the evaluation. Kovacs received 685 responses from people with a disability, family caregivers and representatives from Developmental Services agency staff.

Providing quality information, videos, and resources (n=395)

Informing legal and financial planning for a secure future (n=224)

Offering encouragement, reassurance, and connection to a support network of others they could learn from (n=206)

Providing connections to and information about available services and community supports or resources (n=110)

7.

Gaining information and ideas to help identify opportunities for employment and community involvement
