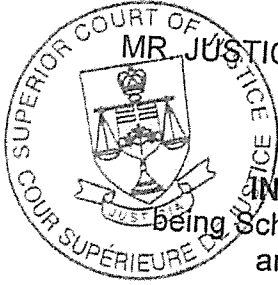

ORDER

THIS APPLICATION, made by the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario for an Order directing the Respondent, Amit Bhambu, to refrain from performing controlled acts that constitute the practice of dentistry, from holding himself out as a dentist or dental surgeon, and from using the title "doctor", or "dentist", or "dental surgeon" or a variation or abbreviation thereof, including "DDS", in the course of providing or offering to provide healthcare in Ontario, was read this day at the Court House, 393 University Avenue, Toronto, ON M5G 1E6.

ON READING the Applicant's Application Record and Factum filed;

1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Respondent, Amit Bhambu, comply with section 9 of the *Dentistry Act* and sections 27 and 33 of the *Regulated Health Professions Act*, and in particular, that the Respondent be and is hereby prohibited, unless or until such time as the Respondent is registered to practice dentistry in the Province of Ontario:
 - (i) from using the title "Dentist", "Dental Surgeon", "Oral Surgeon" or "DDS", or "Doctor", or a variation, abbreviation or equivalent in English or any other language, in Ontario;
 - (ii) from holding himself out as a person who is qualified to practice in Ontario as a dentist or in a specialty of dentistry; and
 - (iii) from performing any controlled acts in Ontario, in relation to dentistry including but not limited to:
 - (a) performing procedures on tissues below the dermis, or below the surface of a mucus member, or in or about the surfaces of teeth, including the scaling of teeth;
 - (b) administering substances by injection or inhalation;
 - (c) communicating to individuals or their personal representatives a diagnosis identifying any disease or disorder as a cause of symptoms of the individual in circumstances in which it is reasonably foreseeable that the individual or his or her representative will rely on the diagnosis;
 - (d) fitting or dispensing a dental prosthesis, orthodontics or periodontal appliance or device used inside the mouth to protect teeth from abnormal functioning; and

(e) dispensing any medication or drugs of any kind or nature.

2. **THIS COURT ORDERS** and directs that the Respondent pay the costs of the Applicant in the amount of \$2,000.00, to be paid to the College within 60 days.
